In 2023 the IIEA awarded 20 students with scholarships that totaled over \$12,100. Since 1980, the IIEA has awarded 880 scholarships totaling \$535,0000. The applicants will be graded on the following criteria: career Grading process: objective, grade point average (GPA), activities and impression. A letter will be sent to all applicants letting them know of the outcome after the scholarship grading occurs in March. Scholarship checks will be sent to the student's college or university in time for fall semester fees. Points are awarded if an applicant has their application signed by an Sponsor: IIEA member.
