Scholarship Sponsor:	Idaho Irrigation Equipment Association (IIEA)
Awarded from:	The Idaho Irrigation Equipment Association, an organization comprised of irrigation equipment manufacturers, manufacturers' representatives, distributors, dealers and support institutions.
Awarded to:	Students interested in the irrigation industry - majors may include Irrigation Engineering, Agricultural Engineering, Horticulture, Crop and Soil Sciences, Agribusiness, Landscape/Irrigation Architecture and Design, Botany, Agriculture/Horticulture Education. Also children of IIEA Members are encouraged to apply.
Who may apply?	Any student accepted into a college program for the fall of 2020 or winter 2021. Scholarships may not be deferred.
Deadline:	Applications must be postmarked by Saturday, February 29, 2020.
Scholarship Amount:	Most scholarships awarded are \$500. In 2019, \$21,000 was awarded to 35 students. Since 1980, the IIEA has awarded 767 scholarships totaling \$466,500.
Grading process:	The applicants will be graded on: career objective, grade point average, activities, and impression. A letter will be sent, sometime in March, to all applicants letting them know the outcome. Scholarship checks will be sent to the student's university by July, in time for fall semester fees.
